### 3. Entries:

All Members/Clubs which are members of National Figure Skating Federations associated with the ISU are invited to take part in this competition.

In case of too many entries, the Organizing Committee reserves the right to limit the number of participants.

## **6. Expenses:**

Travel expenses, accommodation and meals, are at the charge of all participants.

## **7. Liability:**

The organizer will provide Medical Emergency Aid during the competition.

In accordance with ISU Regulations, Rule 119, the organisers may not be held responsible for eventual accidents or other damages to participants, officials or third parties.

## **8. Music:**

Music will be reproduced from a CD-player. CD's must be submitted at the time of registration. Each program(short program, free skating) must be recorded on a separate CD. In addition, competitors must have a backup CD ready for each program.

## **9. Calculation of results:**

The marking system (ISU Judging System) as described in ISU Special Regulations and Technical Rules Single Skating , Rule 352, will be in place in all categories.

## **10. Awards:**

The three best competitors of each event will be awarded with cups.  
All other competitors will receive a gift.

## **11. Draws:**

The draws will take place one hour before each category at the ice rink.
