RULES

The competition will be conducted in accordance with the ISU Special Regulations 2012.

The competition will be held in the following single skating categories:

For the Novice category in accordance with ISU **Communication 1760, or an updated document of this Communication.**

Exceptions: Debs and Advanced Novice will be evaluated with levels B-1-2-3-4 and 5 components.

Participation in Hamar Trophy 2013 is open to all competitors who belongs to an ISU Member, and qualify with regard to eligibility, according to Rule 102, provided their ages fall with the limits specified in Rule 108, par.2. b), c), d). Requirements of ISU Communication 1420 must fulfill. Passports of all skaters, as well as Clearance Certificates if applicable, must be presented at the accreditation of the event for verification .

DEBS

Short Program DEBS girls (max 2.30)

1. 1A or 2A
2. One double jump executed directly from steps. Must be different than number 1.
3. Jump combination consisting of single/double, double/double, triple/single or triple/double. Jumps from 1 or 2 may not be repeated.
4. Lsp (5)
5. CCosp (one change of foot only) with at least two basic positions (5+5)
6. StSq

Short program DEBS boys (max 2.30)

1. 1A or 2A
2. One double jump executed directly from steps. Must be different than number 1.
3. Jump combination consisting of single/double, double/double, triple/single or triple/double. Jumps from 1 or 2 may not be repeated.
4. CCsp or CSsp (6 total)
5. CCosp (one change of foot only) with at least two basic positions (5+5)
6. StSq

Free skating DEBS girls (3 min +/- 10 sec)

- Max 6 jump elements
- One must be an Axel (with any revolution)
- Max 2 combinations/sequences
- Only one of the combinations/sequences may consist of more than two jumps. In the case of sequence only two of the jumps will count (highest value). In the case of a combination all three jumps will count.
- Only 2 jumps with 2 – 2,5 or 3 rotations may be repeated once, but must then be a part of a jump combination/sequence.
- Max 2 spins; one Flying spin in one position (5) and a combination spin(8), (Cosp or CCosp)
- Max 1 StSq

Free skating DEBS boys (3.30 min +/- 10 sec)

- Max 7 jump elements
- One must be an Axel (with any revolution)
- Max 2 combinations/sequences
- Only one of the combinations/sequences may consist of more than two jumps. In the case of sequence only two of the jumps will count (highest value). In the case of a combination all three jumps will count.
- Only 2 jumps with 2 – 2,5 or 3 rotations may be repeated once, but must then be a part of a jump combination/sequence.
- Max 2 spins; one Flying spin in one position (5) and a combination spin(8), (Cosp or CCosp)
- Max 1 StSq

SCHEDULE

Detailed preliminary schedule will be published on the web site of the competition December 1st. 2012. The competition starts 12.00 Friday January 18th and is finished about 18.00 Sunday 20th.

The final detailed schedule with starting orders will be placed on the web site on January 10, 2012.

REGISTRATION OF ENTRIES

Entries of skaters and proposed judges must be submitted by **November 20th 2012** at the latest by using the Entry Form, (Annex 1) also available on the website of the competition.

Each invited club may enter competitors in any category. However, the Organizer reserves the right to limit the number of skaters and to enter more competitors.

The clubs are asked to **list the skaters according to the order in which they wish the skaters to be accepted to the competition.**

Confirmation of the skaters accepted to the competition will be published on the website by **December 1st, 2012.**

We kindly ask the clubs to make **one payment transaction for all its skaters.**

In case a skater has been entered in the competition, but cannot participate, she/he can be replaced by another skater in the same category and class. Participating clubs are asked to immediately inform of any changes in their entries by e-mail: karhoel@online.no

Entry fees are not refunded in case of withdrawal after November 20th 2012. Entry fee will be refunded if the skater is not accepted (if there will be a limitation of the numbers of entries).

DRAW

The draw will be held at Hamar OL-Amfi, **January 8th 2013** and the result will be published on the official web page of the competition on **January 10th 2013**. The start list of the free program will be the opposite of the result of the short program.

COMPOSITION OF PANELS

Participating Clubs and federations are welcome to propose ISU, international or national championship recognized Judges, Technical controllers and Technical Specialists. The host club will make a selection based on the order the candidates are received, country and qualifications. The panels will be announced at December 1th.

The host club will cover the costs of accommodations for all Judges, Technical Specialists, controllers and technical staff during the competition. Travel costs for officials from outside Norway will be born by the respective club/ISU member. The officials will be given money to buy meals.

INITIAL JUDGES MEETING/ROUND TABLE DISCUSSION

Initial judges meeting is held at the rink Friday, January 18th at 10.30.(subject to change). RTD will be announced.

MUSIC

Music must be provided on CD (no CD-RW-s or DVD-s). The CD's equipped with the full name of the competitor, club and category must be submitted to the Organizer at the accreditation. **All competitors must have an extra copy of their music available close to the rink during their event.**

PROTESTS

Protests must be submitted according to rule 123.

AWARDING

The first three standings of each category will be awarded with a prize and diploma. All other competitors receive a diploma.

EXPENSES

The Organizer will not cover any expenses of the teams.

Travel expenses, board and accommodation will be borne by the participants.

TRANSPORTATION AND ACCOMMODATION

The Organizer will arrange transportation for participants, coaches and judges during the competition. There will be bus-transport hotel - ice rink, and the schedule will be listed at the competition hotel and the ice rink.

The Organizer will make the room arrangements for **officials only**.

The competitors and their coaches may book at the competition Hotel which is Scandic Hamar.
